## BACKCOUNTRY ADVISORY

The backcountry outside of Kicking Horse Mountain Resort's operational boundary and controlled recreation area can at times prove to be extremely dangerous and life threatening. Every year multiple involvements with avalanches occur in this area, some resulting in loss of life.

The backcountry outside the resort's posted area boundary is uncontrolled, unmarked, and not patrolled, therefore many unseen hazards and dangers may exist.

Those choosing to leave the ski area boundary do so entirely at their own risk. They should be trained and properly equipped for self rescue as mountain rescue is not available.

Please read the Canadian Avalanche Association Public Avalanche Bulletin prior to making any decisions to leave the area.

Remember catastrophic avalanches may occur at low, moderate, considerable or high danger levels.
